RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement for bids for the 2025 Industrial Road Improvements Project, bids were received, opened and tabulated according to the law, and the following bids were received complying with the advertisement:

The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Musch Construction of Pipestone, Minnesota for the 2025 Industrial Road Improvements Project according to the plans and specifications therefor approved by the City Council and on file in the office of the City Administrator.
2. The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to return forthwith to all bidders the deposits made with their bids, except that the deposits of the successful bidder and the next lowest bidder shall be retained until a contract has been signed.
