Background

 Last year, USPS reached out to staff and council members requesting an ordinance to prohibit parking within 50 ft. of mail boxes

• Reasons:

- Continued affected mail service
- Mail trucks no longer allowed to back up
- Cannot get out of vehicle

Current Parking Ordinance:

- Restrictions on certain streets
- Restrictions for fire hydrants, crosswalks, intersections, railroad crossings, etc.

10 feet Only restricted 10 am - 4 pm M-Sat Harrisonville

Only restricted

Only restricted directly in front of mailbox


No ordinance restrictions

 - c. Only between certain hours?
 - d. Enforcement: complaint-based from USPS only
 - e. Potential alternatives
