- An update to the City Council on the progress and next steps of the 163rd Street Improvements project.

### Background Information:

- The City received a federal Surface Transportation Program grant to make improvements to 163rd Street. This project will completely re-construct the road and add curb and gutter from 7 Hwy to Lexington Rd, and sidewalk trail from 7 Hwy to the west Intermediate School entrance.
- The project design stage is complete, and we are now in the stage of MoDOT approvals and right-of-way acquisition. On February 16th, the Pleasant Hill School Board voted to approve donation of right-of-way, permanent drainage easement, and temporary construction easement.
- Once MoDOT approves the acquisitions and final plans, the project will be advertised and opened for bid. Construction is set to begin in early June, with the roadway being opened back up before the start of school in August.

### Financial Information:

- The total cost of the project is approximately \$550,000.
  - The STP grant amount is for \$200,000.
  - The City will cover the remaining amount of \$350,000 through capital project funds, street overlay funds, and fund balances.
