**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH
MARTUCCI ENGINEERING, LLC FOR PFAS TREATMENT SYSTEM EVALUATION AND
IDENTIFICATION OF RELATED WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT OPTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pennington requires professional engineering services for PFAS-related evaluation of its water system and identification of improvement options;

WHEREAS, Borough Council, on the recommendation of the Superintendent of Public Works, has determined that Martucci Engineering, LLC, with a New Jersey office in Flemington, New Jersey, has the expertise required for this undertaking;

WHEREAS, the proposed Scope of Work is described in the attached letter dated December 8, 2025 from Robert Martucci, PE, to the Borough of Pennington and the attention of GP Caminiti, Administrator, and is further described in the attached request for services by the Superintendent, approved by the Administrator;

WHEREAS, the proposed cost of these services is not to exceed \$12,500;

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough has certified that these funds are available in account 5-05-55-501-000-262, Water/Sewer Engineering;

WHEREAS, the proposed contract, as a contract for professional services, does not require advertising for bids under the Local Public Contracts Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington, that the Mayor, with the attestation of the Borough Clerk, is hereby authorized to enter into the proposed professional services agreement with Martucci Engineering on behalf of the Borough, in an amount not to exceed \$12,500 and subject to a form of contract approved by the Borough Attorney.
