**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF TWO (2) TRASH CART ENCLOSURES FOR  
KUNKEL PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF OPEN SPACE FUNDS  
FOR THIS PURPOSE**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Pennington seeks to purchase two (2) trash enclosures for use at Kunkel Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Public Works has determined that the desired trash cart enclosures are available under State Contract #T0103, Park & Playground Equipment through Kettle Creen Corporation, Contract #: 24-FOOD-118195; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Public Works solicited a quote from Kettle Creek Corporation to provide the desired trash cart enclosures: and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of Quote #20260016 from Kettle Creek Corporation in the amount of \$11,630.16, is attached to this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, Pennington citizens have authorized the creation of an Open Space Trust Fund in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:12-15.7, which authorizes use of such funds for, among other things, development and maintenance of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes, as determined by the governing body of the municipality;

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available in the Open Space Fund for this purchase;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington, that the aforesaid purchase of two (2) trash enclosures from Kettle Creek Corporation, pursuant to the attached quote #20260016 are hereby authorized for an amount not to exceed \$11,630.16, and the Chief Financial Officer and Borough Clerk are further authorized to execute such purchase orders and other documents as are needed to effectuate the work.
