RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CREATION OF THE SEVENTH POLICE OFFICER POSITION AND THE HIRING OF LEO JAY FRIEDMAN AS POLICE OFFICER IN THE PENNINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Pennington Police Department currently has positions for six (6) Police Officers;

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee of Borough Council, on the recommendation of the Chief of Police, has determined that increased workload in the Police Department necessitates creation of an additional, seventh (7th) Police Officer position;

WHEREAS, based on the most recent round of recruitment and interviews, the Chief of Police has recommended the hiring of candidate Leo Jay Friedman to fill this seventh position;

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee has approved this recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the appointment of Mr. Friedman requires him to take both medical and psychological exams and his continued employment will be subject to him successfully passing both of these exams;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington, as follows:

- the creation of a seventh (7th) Police Officer position in the Pennington Police Department and the hiring of Leo Jay Friedman (Class 7) to fill this position is hereby approved, contingent upon him successfully passing both the medical and the psychological exam;
- 2. Mr. Friedman's salary and other terms and conditions of employment shall be governed by the contract between the Borough and the Pennington Borough Police Association;
- 3. Mr. Friedman's start date shall be August 8, 2023.
