History

Before there were apple trees at Edwards Orchard, there were dairy cows for 25 years. In 1964 by Robert Edwards Sr. and his wife, Betty began by selling apples from a hayrack in their front yard and later converting the old dairy barn into a retail space.

In January 2008, a rare winter tornado destroyed six of the orchard's seven buildings—but remarkably, the apple trees were unharmed. That spring construction began to preserve the charm of the original Apple Barn, two historic barns—one from Wisconsin (1860) and another from Illinois (1910)—were relocated and rebuilt on the farm. Architects and construction crews worked around the clock to open the store by September of the same year.

The 2025 fall season has kicked off on August 22nd!
