Re: Engineering Report – June 2026 Activity
Date: July 14, 2026

Please allow this memorandum to provide a brief summary of major activity over the past month that involves the engineering department:

- **2026 Pavement Maintenance:** We received IDOT approval of the plans/specifications and the project was advertised for public bid letting. A resolution to award a construction contract is being presented to the Board at the July 22nd meeting.
- **Surf Internet:** Surf has provided a total of thirty-seven plans to date, and there will be a total of 41 so we are a little over three quarters the way to the finish line. We have recommended approval of 34 plan sets to date. Construction work is underway.
- **Frontier Fiber Optic:** Frontier has submitted a total of fourteen plan sets for review, and six have been approved. Construction work is underway.
- **Bel Air North Subdivision:** NICOR is in the process of installing gas mains which should be complete this week. ComEd has installed a pole along Orth Road and is expected to resume its work at the site in the next week or two. The taxiways have been paved, and additional mass grading has been completed. We continue to monitor the subdivision for differential settlement and are pleased to advise that very little has been observed.
- **Geographical Information System (GIS):** We continue to assemble documents (plan sets, older water/sewer maps/agreements) that will be uploaded in the GIS databases. This effort will be completed by the end of July.
- **South Wastewater Treatment Plant:** Staff continues to make progress. Walk throughs of the South Plant have been completed and list of maintenance measures and/or improvements is being assembled. This work should wrap up at the end of July.
- **Poplar Woods Plat 3 (McDonald's):** Staff has reviewed the plat, permit documents and plans for the third phase of Poplar Woods. Plan revisions are currently in process.
