It is the intent of Congress that the MSCIP be expedited to overcome the significant delays the project has faced, and we thank the USACE for how they have worked with the Calhoun Port Authority to accelerate the schedule for the SEIS.

Please give every consideration to Calhoun Port Authority's request to have their proposal to address the Section 902 Cost Limit for the Matagorda Ship Channel Improvement included in the 2026 Section 7001 Report to Congress on Future Water Resources Development.
