SUBJECT:

LESTER CONTRACTING'S REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXTRA COST

DUE TO RISE IN FUEL COSTS

BACKGROUND:

In July, we received the attached written request from Lester Contracting asking that the City consider paying for the extra cost they have incurred in the material cost of the limestone base for the CDBG-DR Phase 1 project. As explained in the letter, the material supplier was unable to hold the price which had been provided at the time the project was bid. This is unprecedented but occurred because the freight companies demanded more money to cover the increase in fuel prices and went on strike.

We have had discussions with the GLO and Anne Marie and find that there is language in the contract to make this adjustment if Council approves. We have found that we can realize about \$32,000 in savings to offset this additional cost by reducing the project scope as follows: provide grass sod to a single strip behind all curb and gutter with the area behind one strip being seeded instead of sod. In this way, additional City funds would not be required, beyond what has already been committed, should Council approve this request. Recall with Change Order No. 1 the current contract price has currently been reduced by \$9,081.00 less than what has been committed.

The contract includes scope to seed the ditch that runs within the cemetery property, but the cemetery association is working with us to replace the ditch with 2 each 30" storm pipe. It's possible that the seeding of this area may not be required, which would provide additional savings. We are near the end of the project, so we do not anticipate any new additional costs, but of course there are no guarantees until the project is complete.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

By reducing the scope to provide a single row of grass sod behind the curbs and seeding behind that (as opposed to 2 or more rows of grass sod), we can realize enough savings to pay for this additional \$31,406.00.

Mrs. Weaver,

Lester Contracting, Inc. is experiencing first-time pricing challenges from our limestone base supplier. With the recent fuel price increase, our supplier is no longer able to hold the material and freight pricing as originally quoted. Our supplier has always only guaranteed our pricing for 60 days. I have attached the original quote and the new quoted price from the supplier. Honoring this pricing has never been an issue until now. As a result of the high fuel cost, the freight companies hired to ship the limestone went on strike. This is forcing the supplier to pay more for hauling. The freight companies are demanding a 15% fuel surcharge be added to every load hauled.

This project has approx. 4,100 tons of limestone base estimated to build the streets. My original quote for the base was for (Base \$4.50 per ton and Freight \$23.01 per ton for a total cost of \$27.51 per ton). The new price my supplier is quoting now is (\$5.25 per ton and Freight \$29.92 per ton for a total cost of \$35.17). This new pricing equals a total cost of \$7.66 more per ton for the limestone base. The total extra cost LCI would have to cover is 4,100 tons x \$7.66 = \$31,406.00.

LCI is aware that this project is a quoted project. We are also aware that the world is facing challenges today that have never been seen before. LCI would like to ask the City of Port Lavaca to consider helping with this extra cost. LCI is not looking to make any profit from this extra cost. LCI is only looking to recover the expense of the extra cost. Would the City of Port Lavaca be willing to help us with this increase in supplier cost? I have attached a letter from our supplier which shows what they are using to determine the fuel rates and charges.
