Consider and act upon approving the purchase of one (1) 2025 Ford Interceptor for \$49,508 from Silsbee Ford utilizing TIPS Contract 240901 and three (3) 2025 Chevrolet Tahoe's from Reliable Chevrolet for \$50,393 each utilizing the Sheriff's Association of Texas Contract.

Description of Agenda Item:

This purchase includes one (1) Ford Interceptor for \$49,508.25 to be assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division, as approved in the FY25 budget and three (3) Chevrolet Tahoe's as approved in the FY25 budget for \$50,393.00 each to be assigned to the Operations Division as marked patrol vehicles.

Budget Impact:

Fleet additions for the (3) Chevrolet Tahoe's (\$151,179.00) will be funded through the FY25 budget, account 12020010-61450. The (1) one Ford Interceptor (\$49,508.25) will also be funded through 12020010-61450.
