

A RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PROSPER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE TOWN'S LEGISLATIVE AGENDA FOR THE 89TH TEXAS LEGISLATIVE SESSION; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PERSONS TO REPRESENT AND COMMUNICATE THE TOWN'S LEGISLATIVE INTERESTS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND TOWN MANAGER TO SIGN ALL LETTERS, PETITIONS, AND/OR OTHER DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN TO PROMOTE THE TOWN'S LEGISLATIVE AGENDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the 89th Texas Legislature convenes in January 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature and its administrative agencies will consider many measures and actions that may affect the Town of Prosper, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has prepared and recommends approval of the Town of Prosper 2025 Legislative Agenda, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the 2025 Legislative Agenda represents the issues and priorities that are in the best interest of the Town and its citizens, should be adopted, and should be forwarded to the Town's legislative delegation for consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is of the further opinion that the Mayor, the Town Manager and/or the Town Manager's designee should be authorized and directed to take action with regard to the 2025 Legislative Agenda as outlined below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PROSPER, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

The Town of Prosper 2025 Legislative Agenda, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is hereby adopted and approved.

SECTION 2

The Mayor, the Town Manager, and/or the Town Manager's designee are authorized to communicate the items included in the Town's Legislative Agenda to members of the Texas Legislature, in general, and/or to the appropriate legislative committees, committee members, and other persons or groups that may influence the 89th Legislative Session.

SECTION 3

For those items designated as "support," the Mayor, the Town Manager and/or the Town Manager's designee are directed to actively pursue passage of the appropriate legislation if it is introduced by some other entity. Efforts to obtain passage of the legislation may include drafting

appropriate legislation, seeking a legislative sponsor, and actively pursuing passage of such legislation by providing testimony and through other means.

SECTION 4

For those items designated as “oppose,” the Mayor, Town Manager, and/or the Town Manager’s designee are directed to oppose the passage of any such legislation.

SECTION 5

The Mayor and the Town Manager are specifically authorized to sign any and all letters, petitions, and/or other documents on behalf of the Town in order to promote the Town’s 2025 Legislative Agenda.

SECTION 6

When testimony before various committees is needed to support or oppose a bill, the Mayor, the Town Council Members, the Town Manager, or the Town Manager’s designee are authorized to testify so long as the testimony is consistent with the approved 2025 Legislative Agenda.

SECTION 7

This Resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
