Agenda Item:

Consider and act upon the purchase of Stryker Medical Equipment for newly ordered Fire Department apparatus from Stryker Medical through the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) program.

Description of Agenda Item:

Local governments are authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act, V.T.C.A. Government Code, Chapter 791, to enter into joint contracts and agreements for the performance of governmental functions and services, including administrative functions normally associated with the operation of government (such as purchasing necessary materials and equipment).

In October 2018, the Town of Prosper entered into an Interlocal Participation Agreement, which authorized the Town's participation in the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) program for the purchasing of goods and services through the cooperative's publicly procured contracts. Being a part of this program allows the Town to purchase Stryker equipment for the new Central Fire Station while also meeting all competitive bid requirements.

Budget Impact:

The total expenditure for the medical equipment is \$172,429.37. A loose equipment budget was previously approved by the Town Council in FY-2022 for the Pumper-Engine, Quint, and two ambulances. This item will be funded as follows:
