Agenda Item:

Description of Agenda Item:

For instances where the Town is required to mow property and/or remove trash and debris to attain compliance with the Town's ordinances, the Town incurs expenses for which it is not otherwise reimbursed. The division proposes imposing a Town-initiated Code Administrative fee related to expenses incurred.

Assessing this fee will assist with the recouping expenses tied to Town initiated abatements.
