Project/Issue Name: 20-R-19 A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Republic, Missouri, Awarding the Bid for the Fencing and Kennel Construction at the Republic Animal Control Facility.

### **Issue Statement**

To award fencing and kennel construction for the Animal Control Facility to Carnahan White LLC.

### **Discussion and/or Analysis**

The City of Republic requested bids to supply and install 40 dog pens with 6' tall chain link with 3' wide gates. The 20 inside cages approximately 6' 10" x 10' with a 4' tall aluminum divider on each cage. The 20 outside cages approximately 6' x 9' 6" with a top, and outside

perimeter fence of approximately 120' of 6' tall chain link with 2 - 3' wide gates. All materials shall be black poly coated with top and bottom rails on all fence with a 9 ga fused bonded chain link. Post shall be installed with a 1/4" x 6" x 6" plate and 1/2" x 4" anchor bolts.

The City received two bids for this project: Carnahan White at \$53,800 and Midmark Corporation at \$94,036.

### **Recommended Action**

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 20-R-19.
