AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE OF SPECIFIED PORTIONS OF THE TRAIL ALONG WILSON'S CREEK BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri ("City" or "Republic"), is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission ("MHTC") has proposed a Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission Sidewalk Improvements Agreement ("Agreement") with the City for ongoing maintenance of the sidewalk improvements along Wilson's Creek Boulevard on MHTC right-of-way, as further detailed in the Agreement attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, the City will be responsible for maintenance of the improvements including, but necessarily limited to, routine upkeep, repairs, resurfacing, vegetation management, mowing, landscaping, and trash and debris removal, as well as maintenance of related signage, pavement markings, and any other safety features; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the proposed Agreement is appropriate under the identified circumstances and is in the best interest of the City and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

The Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized to execute the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission Sidewalk Improvements Agreement with MHTC for the provision of maintenance on the identified sidewalk improvements specified in the Agreement, attached hereto and labeled "Exhibit 1".

Section 2: The City Administrator, or his/her designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to take the other, additional necessary steps to execute this Ordinance.

Section 3: The WHEREAS clauses above are specifically incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provision hereof is declared invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage as provided by law.
