WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri ("City" or "Republic") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, in March 2025, the City published a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) from interested providers to conduct a comprehensive wage study to evaluate employee compensation and competitiveness, and to provide professional recommendations regarding salary structure; and

WHEREAS, the City received a total of eight (8) responses to its RFQ; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating each written response and meeting with each submitter, a review committee of City staff members ranked the submitting entities using defined scoring criteria, determining CBIZ Benefits & Insurance Services ("CBIZ") to be the most qualified to provide the requested services; and

WHEREAS, based upon staff recommendations, the City Council finds it is in the City's best interest to engage CBIZ for provision of the wage assessment, as set forth in the RFQ.
