

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH REVIZE LLC FOR WEBSITE REDESIGN AND SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Republic, Missouri (“City” or “Republic”) is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recently published a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) (RFP No. 24-002) for a comprehensive website redesign and ongoing website maintenance support (the “Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City received a total of fourteen (14) proposals in response to the RFP; and

**WHEREAS**, after review of the proposals, Revize LLC was chosen as the best website option for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, after hearing presentation and recommendations by City staff, the City Council desires enter into an agreement with Revize LLC, which has demonstrated the necessary qualifications.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Administrator, or their designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Revize LLC for the provision of the a comprehensive website redesign and ongoing maintenance support, under terms consistent with the Sales Agreement attached hereto as “Attachment 1”.

**Section 2.** The City Administrator, or their designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to take the necessary steps to execute this Resolution.

**Section 3.** The whereas clauses are specifically incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect after passage as provided by law.


