

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS CITY VEHICLES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY'S PURCHASING POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Republic, Missouri ("City" or "Republic") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, Parks and Recreation Department staff recently identified several vehicles, including a Mahindra Tractor (the "Tractor") that have become obsolete and are no longer needed for City operations, thus candidates for disposal as surplus property; and

**WHEREAS**, under the City's Purchasing Policy, the City Administrator may sell or exchange "worn-out" or "obsolete" municipal supplies, materials, or equipment having a value of less than \$10,000 as determined by the Finance Director, pursuant to administrative policy, which permits sale at public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Purchasing Policy requires any worn-out or obsolete City property with a value of \$10,000 or more to be declared as surplus by City Council and disposed of at the direction of City Council pursuant to one or more of the methods set forth in the Purchasing Policy, one of which is sale at public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the City had valued the Tractor at under \$10,000, and in accordance with the Purchasing Policy, listed the Tractor on public auction for disposal; and

**WHEREAS**, at auction, however, the Tractor unexpectedly received a selling price of \$11,800 with proceeds totaling \$10,000 thus requiring City Council approval for surplus disposal under the Purchasing Policy; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to complete the transactions and accept the funds for the Tractor and is requesting authorization from the Council to proceed accordingly.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The Mahindra Tractor is hereby declared as surplus property.
- Section 2. The City Administrator, or their designee(s), on behalf of the City, is authorized to dispose of the aforementioned Tractor as surplus property, consistent with applicable City Code and/or administrative policy.
- Section 3. The City Administrator, or their designee(s), on behalf of the City, is authorized to take other reasonable, necessary steps to implement this Resolution.
- Section 4. The whereas clauses are specifically incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect after passage as provided by law.
