

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE NEW ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri (“City” or “Republic”) is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently constructing a new City Hall/Administration Building (“the Project”), which is projected to be completed around November 2025; and

WHEREAS, the expenditures previously approved for the construction of the building do not include the Information Technology infrastructure, which is estimated to total \$564,500; and

WHEREAS, to align with the timeline for substantial completion in November 2025, the City needs to purchase the Information Technology infrastructure in July to ensure timely delivery and installation; and

WHEREAS, based on presentation by staff and all relevant materials submitted, the Council finds it appropriate and necessary to authorize expenditures on the Project with a not to exceed of \$564,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** The City Administrator, or their designee(s), on behalf of the City, is authorized to purchase the Information Technology Infrastructure needs for the new City Hall/Administrative building, at a total cost not to exceed five hundred sixty four thousand five hundred dollars (\$564,500) without separate, additional approval from Counsel. take all reasonable, necessary steps to implement this Resolution.
- Section 2.** The City Administrator, or their designee(s), on behalf of the City, is authorized to take all reasonable, necessary steps to implement this Resolution.
- Section 3.** The whereas clauses are specifically incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect after passage as provided by law.
