

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE BID FOR WATERLINE MATERIALS FOR THE  
REMAINDER OF 2022 THROUGH 2023 TO CORE & MAIN LP**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Republic, Missouri (“City” or “Republic”) is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recently solicited sealed bids for supplying the City its waterline materials for the remainder of 2022 through 2023 (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City received one bid from Core & Main LP, which provided prices on certain materials up to specified dates after which time the price(s) could fluctuate; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the recommendations of City staff, the Council finds that Core & Main LP is a qualified bidder capable of meeting the City’s waterline materials supply needs and should thus be awarded the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1:** Core & Main LP is awarded the Project at the rates listed in its bid, attached hereto and labeled “Exhibit 1”. To the extent materials cannot be provided by Core & Main LP at the prices shown on Exhibit 1, the City shall follow the applicable provisions of the Purchasing and Disposal Policy for obtaining such materials.
- Section 2:** The City Administrator, and/or his designee, is authorized to take the necessary steps to execute this Resolution.
- Section 3:** The WHEREAS clauses are hereby specifically incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 4:** This Resolution shall become effective on and after the date of passage and approval as provided by law.
