

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
FOR THE INFLOW AND INFILTRATION REDUCTION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri (“City” or “Republic”) is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, on or about November 12, 2024, via Ordinance 24-64, the City Council appropriated expenditures from the City’s revenue in accordance with the fiscal year 2025 budget, as approved by council, with authorized adjustments thereto; and

WHEREAS, as part of the aforementioned authorization, the City budgeted for an annual Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Program (“I&I Reduction Program”); and

WHEREAS, the I&I Reduction Program aims to reduce inflow and infiltration into the City’s public sanitary sewer system by identifying and correcting deficient components of the wastewater infrastructure, which includes both publicly and privately owned property and/or components; and

WHEREAS, the I&I Reduction Program may require the use of public funds on the correction of private infrastructure, prompting the need for additional authorization from the City Council as to the allocation of such funds; and

WHEREAS, the I&I Reduction Program will provide a public benefit to the City’s wastewater collection system and treatment plant by reducing the risk of sanitary sewer overflows, reducing the load on system pipes and lift stations, and increasing available capacity at the wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it in the best interest of the City to approve of the requested provision, as such approval will enable the City to timely and effectively begin the I&I Reduction Program, which is expected to provide benefit to the City’s wastewater system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** The City Administrator, or designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to use such public funds as appropriated and authorized by the City Council via Ordinance 24-64, provided such funds are expended in accordance with the approved fiscal year 2025 budget; and
- Section 2.** The City Administrator, or their designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to take the necessary steps to execute this Resolution.
- Section 3.** The whereas clauses are specifically incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect after passage as provided by law.
