Issue Statement

Authorizing the use of public funds on private infrastructure as part of a comprehensive effort to reduce inflow and infiltration into the public sanitary sewer system.

Discussion and/or Analysis

The approved City budget accounts for an annual Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Program. To efficiently operate this program, deficient components of publicly and privately owned wastewater infrastructure need to be identified and corrected. This will require the use of public funds for the correction of private infrastructure. The Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Program will provide a public benefit to the City's wastewater collection system and treatment plant by reducing the risk of sanitary sewer overflows, reducing the load on system pipes and lift stations, and increasing available capacity at the wastewater treatment plant.
