It is the intent of the City that this Invitation for Bid promotes competitive bidding. It shall be the Vendor's responsibility to advise the City if any language, requirements, etc. or any combination thereof, inadvertently restricts or limits the requirements stated in this Invitation for Bid to a single source. Such notification must be submitted in writing and must be received by the Public Works Department not later than three (3) days prior to the bid opening date.

### **INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS**

- 1. Opening Location: The Bid will be opened at the Republic City Hall 213 N. Main St. at 1:00 P.M., local time, ON FRIDAY MARCH 19, 2021.
  - a. All bidders or their representatives are invited to attend the opening of the IFB.
- 2. **Identification:** "IFB" shall refer to this Invitation for Bid. "City" shall refer to the City of Republic, Missouri. Bidder/Vendor/Contractor shall refer to the company, firm, corporation, partnership, or individual who submits this IFB.
- 3. **IFB Delivery Requirements:** Any Bids received after the above stated time and date will not be considered. It shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder to have their Bid delivered to Republic City Hall for receipt on or before the due date and time indicated.
  - a. If a Bid is sent by U.S. Mail, the bidder shall be responsible for its timely delivery to Republic City Hall.
  - b. Bids delayed by mail shall not be considered, shall not be opened, and shall be rejected.
  - c. Arrangements may be made for their return at the bidder's request and expense. However, a copy of all bids shall be maintained and available for public inspection.
  - d. Bids may be mailed to Republic City Hall and accepted if the signed bid form and required information was mailed and received prior to the due date and time.
  - e. Bids sent by email will not be accepted.

Sealed and Marked: If sent by mail, one original signed Bid shall be submitted in one sealed package, clearly marked on the outside of the package with the IFB project name: BUILDS — Bulk Gravel Materials 2021–2022 clearly indicated on the outside of the mailing envelope and addressed to. - 4. **Legal Name and Signature:** Bids shall clearly indicate the legal name, address, and phone number of the bidder (company, firm, corporation, partnership, or individual).
  - a. Bids shall be manually signed above the printed name and title of signer on the Affidavit of Compliance page.
  - b. The signer shall have the authority to bind the company to the submitted Bid.
  - c. Failure to properly sign the Bid form shall invalidate same, and it shall not be considered for award.
  - 5. Corrections: No erasures are permitted.
    - a. If a correction is necessary, draw a single line through the entered figure and enter the corrected figure above it.
    - b. Corrections must be initialed by the person signing the Bid.
  - 6. Clarification and Addenda: Each bidder shall examine all Invitation for Bid documents and shall judge all matters relating to the adequacy and accuracy of such documents.
    - a. Any inquiries or suggestions, concerning interpretation, clarification, or additional information pertaining to the Invitation for Bid shall be made through the individual listed as in the "Inquires" section, in writing or through email.
    - b. The City of Republic shall not be responsible for oral interpretations given by any City employee, representative, or others.
    - c. The issuance of written addenda is the official method whereby interpretation, clarification, or additional information can be given.

- d. It shall be the responsibility of each bidder, prior to submitting their Bid, to contact the individual listed in the "Inquires" section with questions or inquiries.
- 07. **IFB Expenses:** There is no expressed or implied obligation for the City of Republic to reimburse responding firms and the City will not reimburse for any expenses incurred in preparing responses to this request.
- 08. Irrevocable Offer: Any Bid may be withdrawn up until the due date and time set for opening of the IFB. Any Bid not so withdrawn shall, upon opening, constitute an irrevocable offer for a minimum period of 180 days to sell to the City the goods or services set forth in the IFB, until one or more of the Bids have been duly accepted by the City.
- 09. **Responsive and Responsible Bidder:** To be responsive, a bidder shall submit a Bid which conforms in all material respects to the requirements set forth in the Invitation for Bid. To be a responsible bidder, the bidder shall have the capability in all respects to perform fully the contract requirements, and the tenacity, perseverance, experience, integrity, reliability, capacity, facilities, equipment and credit which will ensure good faith performance. The lowest responsible bidder shall mean the bidder who makes the lowest Bid to sell goods or services of a quality which conforms closest to the quality of goods or services set forth in the specifications or otherwise required by the City and who is known to be fit and capable to perform the Bid as made.
- 10. **Reserved Rights:** The City reserves the right to make such investigations as it deems necessary to make the determination of the bidder's responsiveness and responsibility.
  - a. Such information may include, but shall not be limited to: current financial statement, verification of availability of equipment and personnel, and past performance records.
- 11. **The Right to Audit:** The bidder agrees to furnish supporting detail as may be required by the City to support charges or invoices, to make available for audit purposes all records covering charges pertinent to the purchase, and to make appropriate adjustments in the event discrepancies are found.
  - a. The cost of any audit will be paid by the City.
  - b. The City shall have the right to audit the bidder's records pertaining to the work/product for a period of three (3) years after final payment.
- 12. **Applicable Law:** All applicable laws and regulations of the State of Missouri and the City including the City Procurement Regulations and Procedures will apply to any resulting agreement, contract, or purchase order.
  - a. Any involvement with the City Procurement shall be in accordance with the Procurement Regulations and Procedures.
- 13. Right to Protest: Appeals and remedies are provided for in the City Procurement Regulations.
  - a. Protestors shall seek resolution of their complaints initially with the City Purchasing Agent.
  - b. Any protest shall state the basis upon which the solicitation or award is contested and shall be submitted within ten (10) calendar days after such aggrieved person knew or could have reasonably been expected to know of the facts giving rise thereto.
- 14. **Ethical Standards:** With respect to this IFB, if any bidder violates or is a party to a violation of the general ethical standards of the City Procurement Code or the State of Missouri Statues, such bidder may be disqualified from furnishing the goods or services for which the Bid is submitted and shall be further disqualified from submitting any future Bids.
- 15. **Collusion:** By offering a submission to this Invitation for Bid, the bidder certifies the bidder has not divulged, discussed, or compared the Bid with other bidders and has not colluded with any other bidder or parties to this IFB whatsoever. Also, the bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint Bid, each party thereto certifies as to their own organization, that in connection with this IFB:
  - a. Any prices and/or cost data submitted have been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication, or agreement for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices and/or cost data, with any other bidder or with any competitor.

- b. Any prices and/or cost data for this Bid have not knowingly been disclosed by the bidder and will not knowingly be disclosed by the bidder prior to the scheduled opening directly or indirectly to any other bidder or to any competitor.
- c. No attempt has been made or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person or firm to submit or not to submit a Bid for the purpose of restricting competition.
- d. The only person or persons interested in this Bid, principal or principals are named therein and that no person other than therein mentioned has any interest in this Bid or in the contract to be entered into.
- e. No person or agency has been employed or retained to solicit or secure this contract upon an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee exempting bona fide employees or established commercial agencies maintained by the Purchaser for the purpose of doing business.
- 16. **Contract Forms:** Any agreement, contract, or purchase order resulting from the acceptance of a Bid shall be on forms either supplied by or approved by the City.

# 17. Liability and Indemnity:

- a. In no event shall the City be liable to the Contractor for special, indirect, or consequential damages, except those caused by the City's gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct arising out of or in any way connected with a breach of this contract. The maximum liability of the City shall be limited to the amount of money to be paid or received by the City under this contract.
- b. The Contractor shall defend, indemnify and save harmless the City, its elected or appointed officials, agents and employees from and against any and all liability, suits, damages, costs (including attorney fees), losses, outlays and expenses from claims in any manner caused by, or allegedly caused by, or arising out of, or connected with, this contract, or the work or any subcontract thereunder (the Contractor hereby assuming full responsibility for relations with subcontractors), including, but not limited to, claims for personal injuries, death, property damage, or for damages from the award of this contract to Contractor.
- c. The Contractor shall indemnify and hold the City harmless from all wages or overtime compensation due any employees in rendering services pursuant to this agreement or any subcontract, including payment of reasonable attorneys' fees and costs in the defense of any claim made under the Fair Labor Standards Act, the Missouri Prevailing Wage Law or any other federal or state law.
- 18. **IFB Forms, Variances, and Alternates:** Bids must be submitted on attached City IFB forms, although additional information may be attached.
  - a. Bidders must indicate any variances from the City requested specifications and/or terms and conditions, on the IFB Affidavit of Compliance.
  - b. Otherwise, bidders must fully comply with the City requested specifications and terms and conditions. Alternate Bids may or may not be considered at the sole discretion of the City Purchasing Agent.
- 19. Bid Form: All blank spaces must be completed with the appropriate response.
  - a. The bidder must state the price, written in ink, for what is proposed to complete each item of the project.
  - b. Bidders shall insert the words "no bid" in the space provided for an item for which no Bid is made
  - e. The bidder shall submit an executed Bid form and Affidavit of Compliance with other requested documents.
  - d. The type and amount of any supplemental information is left to the Bidders discretion, however, all submitted data may be used to determine the best and lowest bid.

- 20. Modifications or Withdrawal of Bid: A modification for a Bid already received will be considered only if the modification is received prior to the time announced for opening of Bids.
  - a. All modifications shall be made in writing, executed, and submitted on the same form and manner as the original Bid.
  - b. Modifications submitted by telephone, fax, or email will not be considered.
- 21. **No Bid:** If not submitting a Bid, respond by returning the "Statement of No Bid" no later than the stated Bid opening time and date, and explain the reason in the space provided.
- 22. Errors in Bids: Bidders or their authorized representatives are expected to fully inform themselves as to the conditions, requirements, and specifications before submitting Bids; failure to do so will be at the bidder's own risk. Neither law nor regulations make allowance for errors either of omission or commission on the part of bidders. In case of error of extension of prices in the Bid, the unit price shall govern.
- 23. Prices: Bid give both unit price and extended total.
  - a. Price must be stated in units. In case of discrepancy in computing the amount of the Bid, the unit price of the Bid will govern. A (2) two year price guarantee will be accepted.
  - b. All prices shall be F.O.B. destination, freight prepaid (unless otherwise stated in special conditions).
  - c. Each item must be bid separately and no attempt is to be made to tie any item or items in with any other item or items.
  - d. If a bidder offers a discount on payment terms, the discount time will be computed from the date of satisfactory delivery at place of acceptance and receipt of correct invoice at the office specified.
  - e. Payment terms shall be Net 30 if not otherwise specified.
  - f. Pre-payment terms are not acceptable.
- 24. **Discounts:** Any and all discounts except cash discounts for prompt payments must be incorporated as a reduction in the Bid price and not shown separately.
  - a. The price as shown on the Bid shall be the price used in determining award(s).
- 25. **Descriptive Information**: All equipment, materials, and articles incorporated in the product/work covered by this IFB are to be new and of suitable grade for the purpose intended.
  - a. Brand or trade names referenced in specifications are for comparison purposes only.
  - b. Bidders may submit Bids on items manufactured by other than the manufacturer specified when an "or equal" is stated.
- 26. **Deviations to Specifications and Requirements**: When bidding on an "or equal," Bids must be accompanied with all descriptive information necessary for an evaluation of the proposed material or equipment such as the detailed drawings and specifications, certified operation and test data, and experience records.
  - a. Failure of any bidder to furnish the data necessary to determine whether the product is equivalent, may be cause for rejection of the specific item(s) to which it pertains.
  - b. All deviations from the specifications must be noted in detail by the bidder on the Affidavit of Compliance form, at the time of submittal of Bid.
  - c. The absence of listed deviations at the time of submittal of the Bid will hold the bidder strictly accountable to the specifications as written.
  - d. Any deviation from the specifications as written and accepted by the City may be grounds for rejection of the material and/or equipment when delivered.
- 27. **Quality Guaranty:** If any product delivered does not meet applicable specifications or if the product will not produce the effect that the bidder represents to the City, the bidder shall pick up the product from the City at no expense. Also, the bidder shall refund to the City any money which has been paid for same.

- a. The bidder will be responsible for attorney fees in the event the bidder defaults and court action is required.
- 28. **Quality Terms:** The City reserves the right to reject any or all materials if, in its judgment, the item reflects unsatisfactory workmanship, manufacturing, or shipping damages.
- 29. **Tax-Exempt:** The City is exempt from sales taxes and Federal Excise Taxes: Missouri Tax ID Number 12492990.

### 30. Awards:

- a. Unless otherwise stated in the Invitation for Bid, cash discounts for prompt payment of invoices will not be considered in the evaluation of prices. However, such discounts are encouraged to motivate prompt payment.
- b. As the best interest of the City may require, the right is reserved to make awards by item, group of items, all or none or a combination thereof; to reject any and all Bids or waive any minor irregularity or technicality in Bids received.
- c. Awards will be made to the Bidder whose Bid (1) meets the specifications and all other requirements of the Invitation for Bid and (2) is the lowest and best Bid, considering price, delivery, responsibility of the bidder, and all other relevant factors.
- 31. Authorized Product Representation: The successful bidder(s) by virtue of submitting the name and specifications of a manufacturer's product will be required to furnish the named manufacturer's product.
  - a. By virtue of submission of the stated documents, it will be presumed by the City that the bidder(s) is legally authorized to submit and the successful bidder(s) will be legally bound to perform according to the documents.
- 32. **Regulations:** It shall be the responsibility of each bidder to assure compliance with OSHA, EPA, Federal, State of Missouri, and City rules, regulations, or other requirements, as each may apply.
  - a. **Proof of Lawful Residence Required:** Section 208.009 RSMo. shall apply to any contracts awarded under this bid.
- 33. **Termination of Award:** Any failure of the bidder to satisfy the requirements of the City shall be reason for termination of the award.
  - a. Any Bid may be rejected in whole or in part for any reason by the City.
- 34. Royalties and Patents: The successful bidder(s) shall pay all royalties and license fees for equipment or processes in conjunction with the equipment being furnished.
  - a. Bidder shall defend all suits or claims for infringement of any patent right and shall hold the City harmless from loss on account or cost and attorney's fees incurred.
- 35. Equal Employment Opportunity Clause: The City of Republic, in accordance with the provision of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252) and the Regulations of the Department of Commerce (15 CFR, Part 8) issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement that minority businesses will be afforded full opportunity to submit Bids in response to this advertisement and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for award.
- 36. Insurance Requirements: Without limiting any of the other obligations or liabilities of the Contractor, the Contractor shall secure and maintain at its own cost and expense, throughout the duration of this Contract and until the work is completed and accepted by the City, insurance of such types and in such amounts as may be necessary to protect it and the interests of the City against all hazards or risks of loss as hereunder specified or which may arise out of the performance of the Contract Documents. The form and limits of such insurance, together with the underwriter thereof in each ease, are subject to approval by the City. At a minimum, proof of Workers Compensation, Liability, and Automobile Liability insurance shall be presented. Regardless of such approval, it shall be the responsibility of the contractor to maintain adequate insurance coverage at all times during the term of the Contract. Failure of the Contractor to maintain coverage shall not relieve it

of any contractual responsibility or obligation or liability under the Contract Documents. The limits of liability insurance shall be as established annually and published by the Secretary of State in the Missouri Registry. For this project, the required insurance amounts shall be: Workers' Compensation - Statutory coverage per RSMo. 287.010 et seq; Employer's Liability - \$1,000,000.00; Commercial General Liability Insurance - \$2,804,046 for all claims arising out of a single accident or occurrence and \$420,606 for any one person in a single accident or occurrence: Automobile Liability Insurance - covering bodily injury and property damage for owned, non-owned and hired vehicles, with limits of \$2,804,046 for all claims arising out of a single accident or occurrence and \$420,606 for any one person in a single accident or occurrence.

- 37. Nonresident/Foreign Contractors: The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract:
  - a. If the Contractor is a foreign corporation, a certificate of authority to transact business in the State of Missouri from the Secretary of State, unless exempt pursuant to the provisions of Section 351.570 RSMo.
  - b. A certificate from the Missouri Director of Revenue evidencing compliance with the transient employer financial assurance law, unless exempt pursuant to the provisions of Section 285.230 RSMo.
- 38. Bid Tabulation: Bidders may request a copy of the bid tabulation of the Invitation for Bid.
- 39. **Budgetary Constraints:** The City reserves the right to reduce or increase the quantity, retract any item from the Bid, or upon notification, terminate entire agreement without any obligations or penalty based upon availability of funds.
- 40. Additional Purchases by Other Public Agencies: The bidder by submitting a Bid authorizes other public agencies to "Piggy-Back" or purchase equipment and services being proposed in this Invitation for Bid unless otherwise noted on the Affidavit of Compliance Form.
- 41. **Order of Precedence:** Any and all Special/General Conditions and Specifications attached hereto, which varies from the instruction to bidders, shall take precedence.
- 42. **Affidavit for Service Contracts:** The Bidder represents, in accordance with RSMO 285.530.2 that they have not employed, or subcontracted with, unauthorized aliens in connection with the scope of work to be done under the IFB and agrees to provide an affidavit to the City of Republic affirming that they have not, and will not in connection with the IFB, knowingly employ, or subcontract with, any person who is an unauthorized alien.
- 43. **Inspection and Acceptance:** No item(s) received by the City pursuant to this contract shall be deemed accepted until the City has had reasonable opportunity to inspect the item(s).
  - a. Any item(s) which are discovered to be defective or which do not conform to any warranty of the Seller upon inspection may be returned at the seller's expense for full credit or replacement.
  - b. If at a later time, the defects were not ascertainable upon the initial inspection may also be returned at the Seller's expense for full credit or replacement.
  - c. The City's return of defective items shall not exclude any other legal, equitable or contractual remedies the City may have.
- 44. **Terms**: The City of Republic reserves the right to reject any and all proposals received from this bid. It further has the right to negotiate with any qualified source, or to cancel in part or in its entirety this bid. The City also reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate at its sole discretion any and all aspects of this bid process, to obtain further information from any and all respondents, and to waive any defects as to form or content of the bid or any submissions by any firm. This bid does not commit the City to award a contract, to defray any costs incurred in the preparation of a response to this request, or to procure or contract for services. All submissions become the property of the City as public record. All submissions may be subject to public review upon request.

45. Errors and Omissions: Errors or omissions contained within these specifications should be reported immediately to the individual listed in the "Inquiries" Section. If necessary, a written bid addendum will be issued to correct discrepancies.

## 46. Additional Terms:

- a. All materials in this IFB must be delivered to bidder within two weeks of being requested by bidder.
- b. Payment for all products will be at the unit price as bid and the City expressly reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of units purchased as need dictates.
- c. It is in the City's best interest to purchase all materials from the low bidder for each section; however, in the event that supply or delivery of the desired product is not available within a necessary time frame, the City reserves the right to purchase products outside of the bid award.

This is a continuing exemption subject to legislative changes and review by the Director of Revenue. Outlined below are specific requirements regarding this exemption. This summary is not intended as a complete restatement of the law. You should review the law to ensure your understanding and compliance.

- This exemption is not assignable or transferable. It is an exemption from sales and use taxes only and is not an exemption from real or personal property tax.
- Purchases by your agency are not subject to sales or use tax if conducted within your agency's exempt functions and activities. When purchasing with this exemption, furnish all sellers or vendors a copy of this letter.
- · Individuals making personal purchases may not use this exemption.
