The submitted bid from Scurlock Industries of Springfield, Inc., attached and Section 1. labeled "Exhibit 1" and expressly incorporated herein, is accepted for the Project at the estimated cost(s) shown thereon, but in no event to exceed a total of \$117,000 without separate, additional approval from Council. Section 2. The City Administrator, or their designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to take the necessary steps to execute this Resolution. Section 3. The whereas clauses are specifically incorporated herein by reference. Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect after passage as provided by law.
