

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT WITH BURNS & MCDONNELL FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY EXPANSION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri, (herein called the "City") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City previously secured bond funds for the purpose of making various improvements to the City’s wastewater system including the expansion of the Wastewater Treatment Facility;

WHEREAS, the original agreement with Burns & McDonnell for the design-build of the expansion was approved by City Council on February 15, 2022 via Resolution 22-R-09;

WHEREAS, the need to amend the scope of services to mitigate risk in the bedrock and soil was identified, adding an additional cost of \$156,500.00 to the project;

WHEREAS, Council finds this amendment is in the best interest of the City and necessary for structural integrity of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** That the City Administrator is authorized to execute the first amendment to the agreement with Burns & McDonnell to expand the scope of services for the Wastewater Treatment Facility Expansion Project at the cost of \$156,500.00.
- Section 2.** This Resolution shall become effective on and after the date of passage and approval.
- Section 3.** The whereas clauses are hereby incorporated as though fully set forth at length herein.
