A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE BUILDS DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE A CRACK SEALING MACHINE FOR ROADWAY REPAIR

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri ("City" or "Republic") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the BUILDS Department desires to purchase a crack sealing machine for use in the maintenance of city streets; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a governmental purchasing website used by municipalities all over the country to perform and complete the competitive bidding or proposal process; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell located a Crafco Inc. SS125 D Crack Sealing Melter for \$61,752 with \$1,900 in added shipping costs, to total \$63,652; and

WHEREAS, the BUILDS Department sought additional quotes, which confirmed the Crafco product located by Sourcewell was the most economical option for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to purchase the Crack Sealing Melter from Crafco, Inc. at the price(s) shown on the quote provided to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Administrator and/or his designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to enter into an agreement with Sourcewell and Crafco, Inc. for the purchase of a SS125 D Crack Sealing Melter, as specified in the quote from Crafco, Inc., attached hereto as "Attachment 1," and incorporated by reference, at the estimated price of \$63,652.
- **Section 2.** The City Administrator, or his designee(s), on behalf of the City, authorized to take all other reasonable, necessary steps to implement this Resolution.
- **Section 3.** The whereas clauses are specifically incorporated herein by reference.
- **Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect after passage as provided by law.
