A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, SELECTING THE VENDOR AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE FIREWORKS DISPLAY FOR THE ANNUAL HAVE-A-BLAST PATRIOTIC CELEBRATION

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri, (herein called the "City" and "Republic") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited sealed proposals through a request for qualifications (herein called the "RFQ") for a vendor to provide the fireworks display for the City's annual Have-A-Blast Patriotic Celebration (herein called the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, two vendors provided duly submitted proposals for the Project, all being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the RFQ, the Council has selected Gateway Pyrotechnical Productions, LLC for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Based upon the RFQ received by the City, Gateway Pyrotechnical Productions, LLC, is selected for the Project.
- Section 2. The City Administrator or designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to enter into an agreement with Gateway Pyrotechnical Productions, LLC, for the Project. Said agreement shall not exceed a term of three years and shall not exceed \$30,000.00 for the year 2021, \$35,000.00 for the year 2022, and \$35,000.00 for the year 2023.
- Section 3. The City Administrator, or designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to take the necessary steps to implement this Resolution.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective on and after the date of passage and approval as provided by law.
