

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI,
SELECTING THE VENDOR AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO
ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF
THE CITY'S GATEWAY SIGN ALONG HIGHWAY 60**

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri, (herein called the "City" and "Republic") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited sealed bids through an invitation for bids (herein called the "IFB") for a vendor to provide the construction and installation for the City's gateway sign along Highway 60 (herein called the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, one vendor provided a duly submitted bid for the Project, all being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the IFB, the Council has selected Springfield Sign and Graphics, Inc. for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Based upon the IFB received by the City, Springfield Sign and Graphics, Inc., is selected for the Project.
- Section 2. The City Administrator or designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to enter into an agreement with Springfield Sign and Graphics, Inc., for the Project. Said agreement shall not exceed \$233,750.50 and to be substantially similar to the terms and specifications contained in the attached IFB response from Springfield Sign and Graphics, Inc.
- Section 3. The City Administrator, or designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to take the necessary steps to implement this Resolution.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective on and after the date of passage and approval as provided by law.
