

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 101 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF RICHLAND CENTER RELATING TO AUTHORIZATION OF STOP SIGNS ON NORTH CONGRESS STREET AT ITS INTERSECTIONS WITH 2ND STREET AND 4TH STREET.

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that the installation of additional stop signs on North Congress Street will improve public safety, traffic regulation, and neighborhood accessibility, enhancing visibility and reducing potential conflicts at key intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee has reviewed and recommended approval of the proposed stop sign locations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Richland Center, Richland County, Wisconsin, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Subparagraph 101.04(1)(ssss) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Richland Center relating to placement of additional stop signs is created to read:

(ssss) on North Congress Street at its intersections with 2nd Street and 4th Street

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
