Motion to approve an amendment to the FY 2024-2025 budget in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 to cover expenditures approved in the previous budget year.

Discussion was held regarding the total number of units needed and the amount of funding to allocate. Discussion was also held regarding recurring costs associated with the equipment.

Motion to approve the quote submitted by Peacemaker Technologies for police vehicle mobile data terminals as a package deal with the recently purchased handheld ticket writer platform, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.

Motion to authorize the purchase of PowerDMS at the quoted cost structure of approximately \$4,000 for the first year, \$2,600 for the second year, and \$13,000 for the third year, for a total cost not to exceed \$19,600 over three years.
