My mom & and I had to be trained by multiple home health nurses on how to change his antibiotic every couple of hours. In addition, he was unable to work. This was an extra added stress to our family. Not having him at home and also not having him able to work caused us to have a huge strain on our family. It was difficult to manage trying to focus on my schoolwork, while also trying to help my mom while my dad was in the hospital. It was a scary time because I didn't know what was going to happen with my dad either. The most frustrating part was that my mom and I were unable to see my dad during this time. Later, I decided to help my family financially by getting a job. I hadn't ever worked before, but I felt the need to do more than what I was doing. Things were very tight for us and any extra money was helpful. I have been working downtown at The Local since then. My job provided me with a sense of accomplishment and pride. I now was able to help more than I ever thought was possible. Not only was I helping my family financially, but I was also learning the responsibility it takes to keep a

job. This unfortunate event gave me a glimpse of what being an adult is like. We might never know why something happens, but I learned that it is never up to us. This has truly shaped me into the person that I am today, and it has also prepared me for this crazy world that I am about to step into.

I am very blessed to be able to continue my education.. After what I have experienced with my dad over the past year, I am very passionate about pursuing a degree in nursing. In our world today with Covid19, medical workers are in great demand and that is why I feel continuing my education is so important. I feel I could make a difference in the lives of others.
