Village of Ridgeway Contract Law Enforcement Report

Reporting Period: July 14, 2026 – Present

Total Calls for Service: 34

Summary of Activities

During the reporting period, routine patrols were conducted throughout the Village of Ridgeway. Special attention was given to Main Street, County Road H, and US 18/151 due to ongoing speed-related concerns. High-visibility patrols during peak travel hours continued to improve speed compliance.

A variety of shifts were worked, including dedicated weekend coverage to address higher activity levels and community needs. Four traffic citations were issued during this period, along with additional traffic stops and educational contacts.

E-bike enforcement and education also occurred, focusing on improper operation and safe use within the village.

Calls for Service

A total of 34 calls for service were handled, including:

- Traffic stops
- Traffic complaints
- Citizen assists
- Building checks
- Ordinance-related matters
- Motorist assist

While the contracted deputy was off duty, on-shift deputies handled:

- A noise complaint in the Main Street / Richards Street area
- An arrest stemming from a domestic incident

Ordinance Follow-Up

Follow-up continued on several local ordinance issues, including delinquent dog licenses and junk vehicle violations. Multiple cases saw corrective action and voluntary compliance after resident contact.

Keane Street ordinance violations remain largely unresolved at this time. The property owner was given a deadline of August 8, 2026 to correct the violations. Follow-up will occur after that date to determine compliance.

Observations

- Traffic enforcement in targeted areas contributed to improved driver behavior.
- E-bike education has been effective in addressing recurring concerns.
- Community feedback regarding patrol presence and ordinance follow-up has been positive.
- No major hazards were identified during patrols.

Closing Summary

From July 14, 2026, to the present, patrol activity, ordinance enforcement, and community engagement have contributed positively to public safety in the Village of Ridgeway. Traffic enforcement, including four citations, remains focused on Main Street, County Road H, and US 18/151. Additional follow-up on Keane Street violations will be conducted after the August 8 deadline.
