CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Meeting called to order by Chair Casper at 6:44pm.

CONSENT AGENDA

CORRESPONDENCE, ANNOUNCEMENTS, AND REPORTS

Johnson announced the pickleball league will start on Thursday, June 8 at 1pm. Johnson will announce the pickleball league on Facebook.

2. Next Meeting is June 27th

3. Farmers Market Updates

Johnson gave an update on the dog park. \$62.50 was raised in one day at the concession stand. Casper mentioned she now has firework donation buckets out at the concession

stand, but will bring the dog park donation buckets out once the July Fourth Celebration event is over.

5. Library Programming Updates (Maggie)

Johnson mentioned Duke Otherwise is playing at the Ridgeway Community Center on June 13 at 4pm. All ages are welcome. Johnson also mentioned the library's summer camp will start on June 22nd. 13 kids have signed up.

6. Home of the Cardinals, Baseball Parking, Shelter Cardinal Signs (Maggie)

Johnson presented quotes from Vital Signs for the Home of the Cardinals, baseball parking, and shelter cardinal signs. Doug Foster created and painted the current signs, but they are fading and peeling. Johnson mentioned she has reached out to companies about repainting the signs, but they won't do it because they don't have the original artwork. The commission discussed the July Fourth Celebration details. Casper noted the board authorized to spend up to \$15,000 at the May 31st meeting. Johnson and Casper went over the day-of timeline, advertising, t-shirt and koozie details, and volunteer slots. Casper will reach out to community members to fill in empty volunteer spots.
