

Village of Ridgeway – Contracted Deputy Report

Reporting Deputy: Faull

Reporting Period: August 5, 2026 – Present

Total Calls for Service: 22

Summary of Activities

During this reporting period, routine patrols were conducted throughout the Village of Ridgeway with continued emphasis on speed enforcement along Main Street, County Road H, and US 18/151. A variety of shifts were worked, including additional weekend coverage due to increased activity levels.

Traffic enforcement remained steady, with multiple traffic stops conducted. This enforcement resulted in two arrests stemming from traffic stops and one criminal traffic referral submitted to the District Attorney.

Calls for Service

A total of 22 calls for service were handled during this period. These included:

- Traffic stops
- Welfare checks
- Ordinance matters
- Suspicious activity
- Probation assists

While the contracted deputy was off duty, the following incidents were handled by on-shift deputies:

- Harassment issues on Grove Street
- A property damage case on Grove Street
- An arrest stemming from a domestic incident

Ordinance Follow-Up

There has been a small amount of progress at the Keane Street residence following initial contact with the property owner on August 5, 2026. The property owner reported that health issues have slowed his progress. He also noted the need to replace the roof over the garage and rebuild the back wall due to structural concerns, both of which have contributed to delays.

On September 2, 2026, Deputy Faull met with the property owner again to assess updates. The owner stated he has contacted an individual who is expected to remove the large junk camper within the next week.

Deputy Faull will continue meeting with the property owner weekly to monitor progress and support compliance with village ordinances.

Observations

- Speed enforcement continues to positively influence driver behavior in targeted areas.
- Community feedback regarding patrol activity and ordinance follow-up remains positive.
- No major hazards were observed during patrols.

Closing Summary

From August 5, 2026 to the present, patrol duties, enforcement actions, and ordinance follow-up have contributed positively to public safety within the Village of Ridgeway. Weekly reviews of progress on the Keane Street property will continue to ensure ongoing compliance moving forward.
