Marshal's Message

Take the time to clear your vehicle windows of snow, ice, and frost. State law requires the front, side, and rear windows of a vehicle not to be obstructed, obscured, or have a condition that impairs the driver's clear view of the highway or any intersections.

Clearing only a portion of glass directly in front of you will likely lead to a traffic stop. Let's keep everyone safe and Happy New Year.
