Activities/Calls

- Over 23 calls and traffic stops.
 - 1 VIN inspection
 - Traffic stops included speeding of 39 MPH in 20 MPH School Zone.
 - Citations were issued for speeding, dog at large, running a stop sign.
 - Assisted EMS with a medical call.
 - Assisted WHP with fatal crash investigation, I90 closure, and illegal parking on off ramp.
 - Other calls include: animal related, traffic complaints, junk/trash complaints, obstructed sidewalk, obstructed fire hydrant, welfare check, and vandalism of a vehicle.
 - Assisted FBI with missing person investigation.
 - Attended Circuit Court for Sheriff's Office dog bite trial.
- Covered front desk at Town Hall for staff vacations.
- Ranchester has a new Wyolink radio talkgroup added to Ranchester radios and dispatch.
 - Limited staff in the communications center makes sharing a channel more efficient.
- Installed cellular booster in Marshal vehicle (cellular modem is used to communicate with dispatch).
- K9
 - Standby for firearms search related to vehicle crash on Hwy 14, and missing persons in Weston Co.
 - Training
 - Over two-hour old mountain trail over 3 miles long
 - Area search at the end of a long mountain track.
 - Very few K9's can switch between live-find area, and tracking.
 - Double blind firearms searches at B3 K9 Training Facility
 - Shell casings in large outside search area.
 - Firearms and shell casings in large indoor search areas.
