

**Transfer of Water/Sewer Retained Earnings

To see if the Randolph Town Council will vote to authorize the following transfer from the Retained Earnings of the Town's Water/Sewer Enterprise Fund for the purpose identified below:

Explanation: The DPW is seeking a \$300,000 transfer to begin water curb-stop excavations as part of the Lead Service Line Inventory identification project. This will fund a contract with a third party vendor to dig curbstops at the most vulnerable properties listed as "unknown" for water service line materials. This includes schools, daycares, nursing homes, senior buildings, etc... Curbstop excavations allow for review of both the public and private sides of the service line. For full EPA compliance, both sides of the water line must be fully identified. This project is expected to last up to 1 year
