



Outreach

- Town Website News Post
- Email alerts to ~15,000 subscribers through Town Website, Library Website, and RICC Website
- Paper Surveys (in all 4 languages) distributed to town businesses as well as seniors at RICC and library patrons
- Survey placed on homepage of library and RICC websites
- Social Media Posts
- Town-Wide Mailing to ~14,000 households
- Assistance from community leaders and town council in spreading the word
- Banners with website and QR code placed at 4 strategic town locations
- Press release sent to newspaper
- RPS sent survey out to parents and several teachers were able to include the survey as an in-classroom activity
- Flyers sent to local churches
- Survey promoted at all covid test kit distribution sites (including outreach events)
- Flyer posted on local cable via RCTV
- Flyers distributed to local businesses via Connect 24 Business Alliance




Responses - Overview

- 2,009 “clicks” on bit.ly link to survey




Responses - Demographics


Gender





Age


Responses - Demographics






Responses - Covid Impact


Assistance Needed

ARPA Priorities & Allowed Spending

Some areas this funding can be used for are:


- Respond to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
- Address the negative economic impacts the community has experienced as a result of COVID-19.
- Provide assistance in disproportionately impacted areas.
- To offset reductions in local government revenue due to COVID-19.
- Invest in water and/or sewer infrastructure.
- Invest in broadband infrastructure.

The funds cannot be used for:

- Tax reductions or cuts
- Pension fund payments/deposits
- Legal Settlements
- To meet Federal grant match requirements
- Roads and Bridges
