

## **Report of the Master Plan Implementation Committee to The Randolph Planning Board**

May 29, 2023

The Master Plan Implementation Committee (MPIC) has been charged with:

- Working with town departments, boards and committees to review Master Plan goals, chart progress toward achieving those goals and facilitate removal of barriers and obstacles affecting implementation.
- Providing quarterly updates to the Town Manager regarding implementation status and
- Conducting community outreach activities to educate the public about the Master Plan and the progress being made.

The MPIC analysis of our current Town of Randolph Master Plan progress to date in the 7 subject matter areas is:

- Land Use: 7 Goals, 5 are Ongoing, 2 are in Review
- Economic Development: 8 Goals, 2 are Ongoing, 2 are in collaboration with the Chamber of Commerce, 2 are in Review
- Housing: 4 Goals, 2 are Ongoing, 2 are in Consideration through the MBTA Communities Initiative
- Open Space and Recreation: 7 Goals, 5 are Ongoing, 1 is in Consideration by the Recreation Board, assisted by the DPW
- Natural and Cultural Resources: 10 Goals, 1 is Ongoing, 4 have been Completed
- Services and Facilities: 12 Goals, 5 are Ongoing, 5 are in review
- Transportation: 5 Goals, 3 are Ongoing, 2 are in Consideration

Since 2017, when our current Master Plan was adopted, much has changed in the Randolph community and, as you can see from above, much work has already been done with respect to our Master Plan.

For these reasons the Master Plan Implementation Committee recommends that the Planning Board perform an update the Town of Randolph Master Plan.

The update or amendment to the Comprehensive Master Plan should include an updated Open Space and Recreation Plan; which upon completion of the Master Plan, would be usable as a separate document.
