Transfer of General Fund Free Cash to FY25 RPS Operating Budget

To see if the Randolph Town Council will vote to approve a transfer of \$63,485 from the certified General Fund free cash to the FY25 Randolph Public Schools operating budget.

Explanation: These projects have been funded with ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) funds to improve recreational facilities in Randolph, specifically the track at Randolph High School (RHS), the J.F.K. basketball courts, and the M.E. Young & R.C.M.S. tennis courts. The RHS track was completed last year, but the costs for the additional projects exceeded initial estimates, partly due to a change order for replacing fence skirting. This transfer of additional funds is intended to cover those extra costs, allowing the town to finalize and close out the projects.

The initiative benefits both Randolph Public Schools students and the broader community by enhancing local recreational spaces. The community response to these improvements has been overwhelming positive, underscoring the project's value in providing accessible, high-quality recreational facilities for Randolph residents and our R.P.S. athletic teams.
