Sec. 7-52. - Placement of residential containers.

Residential solid waste containers shall be placed at the curb or edge of the abutting street prior to 7:00 a.m. on the regularly scheduled pickup day but no earlier than twenty-four (24) hours prior to that time. Residential solid waste containers shall be removed from the curb or edge of the abutting street and stored behind the building line of the dwelling unit no later than 11:00 p.m. on the day following the regularly scheduled pickup day. This provision shall not apply when the waste collection agency fails to make pickup on the regularly scheduled pickup day.

Section 23-2 Collection Service

Solid waste and recycling containers shall be placed at the curb or street edge but shall not be placed in the street for weekly collection by the town's solid waste collection service. They shall be placed in the required location no earlier than 7:00 p.m., on the day preceding a designated pickup day and shall be removed from the curbside location no later than 7:00 p.m., on the designated pickup day. Except during these hours, the containers shall be kept in a location no closer to the street than the front of the residential structure. The Director of Public Works may make deviations to this section including service for physically disabled residents, where the Director determines such is necessary and in the best interest of all parties concerned. ('75 Code, § 9.42) (Ord. 0-77-05)
