Summary: The City has received a formal request from the Castillo-Mayor family regarding the arrival of a new business located at 1310 N. 7th St. The establishment, Las Tapatias Family Kitchen, Inc., doing business as Birrieria Las Tapatias, is requesting the creation of a new Class R-2 liquor license.

The Class R-2 license allows for the retail sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises by restaurants without a bar. Additionally, the Class R-2 license permits the retail sale of packaged alcoholic beverages, provided that such sales do not exceed ten percent of the total sales of all alcoholic beverages.

The Liquor Commissioner, John Bearrows, has reviewed the request and has no objection to the transaction.
