**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A DB41 BACKYARD DIGGER DERRICK
THROUGH ALTEC INDUSTRIES**

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WHEREAS, Section 7 of Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois provides that a municipality that is not a home rule unit shall only have the powers granted to them by law and as such the City of Rochelle, Ogle County, Illinois being a non-home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of said Section 7 of Article VII, and may exercise only the powers expressly granted by law; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly granted non-home rule municipalities broad authority to “pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities.” 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and

WHEREAS, while “non-home rule municipalities have the authority to enact ordinances, such ordinances may in no event conflict with state law or prohibit what a state statute expressly permits . . . A local ordinance may impose more rigorous or definite regulations in addition to those enacted by the state legislature so long as they do not conflict with the statute.” (*Village of Wauconda v. Hutton*, 291 Ill. App. 3d 1058, 1060 (1997)); and

WHEREAS, the City of Rochelle, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, operates an electric utility through its municipal enterprise known as Rochelle Municipal Utilities (“RMU”) and

WHEREAS, RMU must regularly replace and maintain specialized equipment necessary to provide reliable electric service and maintain electrical distribution infrastructure throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Electric Department's existing 2011 tracked backyard digger derrick has reached the end of its useful service life, has experienced increasing maintenance and repair needs, and is due for replacement to ensure continued operational efficiency and reliability; and

WHEREAS, a tracked backyard digger derrick is a specialized piece of equipment that is essential for the installation, maintenance, and repair of electrical distribution facilities located in backyards, easements, and other areas inaccessible to conventional line trucks and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Altec Industries has submitted pricing for the proposed equipment through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program pursuant to Sourcewell Contract No. 110421-ALT, at a total cost of Two Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$258,171.00), including delivery (see Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell competitively solicits and awards contracts through a nationally recognized cooperative purchasing process in accordance with the Illinois Governmental Joint Purchasing Act, 30 ILCS 525/1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, by utilizing the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, the City is able to obtain competitively procured pricing for the equipment while avoiding the additional time, expense, and administrative burden associated with conducting a separate formal bidding process; an

WHEREAS, the City may waive competitive bidding requirements by a two-thirds vote of the City Council pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code and Section 2-371 of the Rochelle Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Corporate Authorities of the City of Rochelle that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to waive competitive bidding and purchase the Altec DB41 41-foot tracked backyard digger derrick from Altec Industries through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHELLE, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE: That the City hereby incorporates all of the recitals above into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: The Mayor and City Council of the City of Rochelle hereby waive competitive bidding requirements and approve the purchase of an Altec DB41 41-foot tracked backyard digger derrick from Altec Industries in the amount of \$258,171.00.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

SECTION FOUR: Where the conditions imposed by any provisions of this Ordinance are more restrictive than comparable provisions imposed elsewhere in any other local law, ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation, the regulations of this Ordinance will govern.

SECTION FIVE: The City Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
