**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE NEW BOBCAT T86 COMPACT TRACK
LOADER UNDER SOURCEWELL CONTRACT 020223-CEC**

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WHEREAS, Section 7 of Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois provides that a municipality that is not a home rule unit shall only have the powers granted to them by law and as such the City of Rochelle, Ogle County, Illinois being a non-home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of said Section 7 of Article VII, and may exercise only the powers expressly granted by law; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly granted non-home rule municipalities broad authority to “pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities.” 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and

WHEREAS, while “non-home rule municipalities have the authority to enact ordinances, such ordinances may in no event conflict with state law or prohibit what a state statute expressly permits . . . A local ordinance may impose more rigorous or definite regulations in addition to those enacted by the state legislature so long as they do not conflict with the statute.” (*Village of Wauconda v. Hutton*, 291 Ill. App. 3d 1058, 1060 (1997)); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance and repair of a wide variety of assets and infrastructure throughout the City of Rochelle; and

WHEREAS, compact track and skid loaders are key machines used by the Department because of their versatility and ability to operate a broad array of attachments, thereby reducing the need for multiple specialized machines; and

WHEREAS, the City has a significant inventory of Bobcat attachments, many of which are designed to operate exclusively with Bobcat loaders, and the Public Works Department has successfully used Bobcat equipment for more than 20 years with proven reliability and efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the City’s 2026 budget includes funds to replace a 2016 Bobcat T770 compact track loader; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works department received a quote from Bobcat of Dixon using SourceWell competitive bid pricing (Contract 020223-CEC) for a Bobcat T86 compact track loader with a new 84” sweeper bucket and 84” angle broom in the amount of \$115,554.75, the quote attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the current 2016 Bobcat T770 and broom attachments will be transferred to the Water Department for continued use; and

WHEREAS, the City may waive competitive bidding requirements by a two-thirds vote of the City Council pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code and Section 2-371 of the Rochelle Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Corporate Authorities of the City of Rochelle that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to waive competitive bidding and purchase the 2016 Bobcat in the amount of \$115,554.75 from Bobcat of Dixon, under Sourcwell Contract 020223-CEC.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ROCHELLE, ILLINOIS:**

SECTION ONE: That the City hereby incorporates all of the recitals above into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: The Mayor and City Council of the City of Rochelle hereby waive the competitive bidding requirements and approve the purchase of a 2016 Bobcat in the amount of \$115,554.75 from Bobcat of Dixon, under Sourcwell Contract 020223-CEC.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

SECTION FOUR: Where the conditions imposed by any provisions of this Ordinance are more restrictive than comparable provisions imposed elsewhere in any other local law, ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation, the regulations of this Ordinance will govern.

SECTION FIVE: The City Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
