RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A 2,000 GALLON SPREADER FOR THE WATER RECLAMATION DEPARTMENT

- **WHEREAS**, Section 7 of Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois provides that a municipality that is not a home rule unit shall only have the powers granted to them by law and as such the City of Rochelle, Ogle County, Illinois being a non-home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of said Section 7 of Article VII, and may exercise only the powers expressly granted by law; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Illinois General Assembly granted non-home rule municipalities broad authority to "pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities." 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City provides utility services including electric, water, sewer, wastewater treatment, and advanced communications to the greater Rochelle Community through the Utility Department, which is commonly referred to as Rochelle Municipal Utilities (RMU); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Water Reclamation Department generates sludge as a by-product of the water reclamation process, which is disposed of in the City's landfill; and
- **WHEREAS**, the sludge consists of approximately 80% water, which adds to the cost of transporting and disposing of the sludge; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Water and Water Reclamation has determined that the sludge can be spread out and dried by the sun, to eliminate the excess water from the sludge; and
- **WHEREAS**, after the sludge is dried it may meet EPA requirements to spread on land and used as fertilizer for farms; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Water and Water Reclamation is performing testing to determine if the sludge can be land applied after drying and has interest from local farmers to take the dehydrated sludge to be used as fertilizer on their respective farms; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Water and Water Reclamation has located a used H.S. 5120 Topshot Slinger 2,000-gallon spreader for \$18,500.00, as offered in Exhibit 1, attached hereto; and
- **WHEREAS**, the process of dehydrating the sludge will reduce the amount of waste sent to the landfill, reduce the City's expense of transferring the sludge to the landfill, and could repurpose the sludge as fertilizer; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council find that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to authorize the City Manager to purchase a H.S. 5120 Topshot Slinger Manure 2,000-

gallon Spreader in an amount not to exceed \$18,500.00; with the same pricing terms as the quote attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Rochelle as follows:

<u>SECTION ONE.</u> The foregoing Recitals are not mere preparatory language but are hereby incorporated in this Section 1 as if said Recitals were fully set forth.

<u>SECTION TWO.</u> The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to purchase a H.S. 5120 Topshot Slinger Manure 2,000-gallon Spreader in an amount not to exceed \$18,500.00; with the same pricing terms as the quote attached hereto as <u>Exhibit 1</u>, subject to review by the City attorney.

<u>SECTION THREE.</u> The provisions of this Resolution are severable and if any court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any portion of this Resolution to be invalid or unenforceable, said decision shall not affect any portion of this Resolution, other than the part declared invalid or unenforceable. This City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted this Resolution even with the invalid or unenforceable portion deleted.

<u>SECTION FOUR.</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

<u>SECTION FIVE.</u> That any resolution or motion in conflict with this Resolution is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts with this Resolution.
