Chief's Blotter

***Note** that Overtime hours for the Winter Weather Event are not included on this month's report because they fell on the March 2 week payroll period.

Winter Weather Event: RPD officers improvised and sacrificed to ensure 24/7 coverage. Operations never ceased and we maintained a presence for the entirety of the event. Officers were able to patrol our entire city as well as some neighboring areas that could not be serviced by their own law enforcement. We assisted with public works duties and closely monitored our most vulnerable citizens. I commend my troops on their performance during this emergency operation.

Traffic: Officers are monitoring increased through traffic from Stratford on to Riley as people leave Zilker Park on the weekends. Meetings have resumed with TEXDOT officials in regards to traffic safety on Bee Caves during flooding events. RPD is continuing to enforce only serious traffic violations to minimize contacts during the ongoing COVID situation.

Criminal Activity: We are working several cases of catalytic converters in our city. Theft prevention signage has been installed in some RW business parking lots as part of our awareness campaign. With improved weather we are seeing an increase in door to door solicitation.
