2 **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-07-16-12** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, 3 TEXAS ADOPTING A WATER CONSERVATION PLAN AND A DROUGHT 4 5 CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD TO PROMOTE **RESPONSIBLE USE OF WATER AND ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR THE** 6 7 INITIATION AND TERMINATION OF DROUGHT RESPONSE STAGES INCLUDING 8 **RESTRICTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND/OR SEVERABILITY AND** 9 **AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** WHEREAS, the City of Rollingwood, Texas (City), recognizes that the amount of water available 10 to its citizens and customers is limited; and 11 WHEREAS, the City recognizes that drought, system failure and other acts of God may occur and 12 that the City cannot guarantee an uninterrupted water supply for all purposes at all times; and 13 WHEREAS, the City desires to conserve water resources and prepare for drought; and 14 WHEREAS, the City desires to comply with Section 11.1271 of the Texas Water Code and 15 applicable rules of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality which require these plans for 16 all public water supply systems; and 17 WHEREAS, the City desires to comply with the rules of the Texas Water Development Board 18 should it decide to avail itself of various financial assistance programs found in Title 31, Texas 19 Administrative Code Chapter 363; and 20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 54 of the Local Government Code and in the best interests of its 21 22 citizens, the City is authorized to adopt Ordinances it deems are necessary and expedient to preserve and conserve its water resources and to prepare for drought; 23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS 24 **THAT:** 25 The City Council does hereby find and declare that sufficient and timely written 26 Section 1. notice of place and subject matter of this meeting adopting this Ordinance was posted. The City 27 Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the posting thereof. 28 Section 2. The City Council adopts the Water Conservation & Drought Contingency Plans 29 attached to this ordinance as Exhibits "A" and "B" respectively. All ordinances that are in conflict 30 with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed. 31 32 Section 3. Should any paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected. 33 34 Section 4. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance.
