- **Name change**: The public facing name of the club will be changing from Western Hills Athletic Club to Rollingwood Athletic Club. Rest assured that I met with Alun Thomas before this took place to make sure that the city didn't have any concerns which they didn't.
- **New committees**: the board approved the creation of six standing committees:
 - **Aquatics**: Mark Monti (chair), Steve Marcie, Zach Elkins
 - **Racquet**: Zach Elkins (chair), Dave French, Jeni Paul, Sarah Stotts
 - **Finance & Risk**: Jeni Paul (chair), Edward Henigin, Dave French
 - **HR & Governance**: Scott Buckholtz (chair), Mark Monti, Heather Raymond
 - **Members & Marketing**: Heather Raymond (chair), Jeni Paul, Sarah Stotts
 - **Physical Plant**: Edward Henigin (chair), Scott Buckholtz
- **Austin Country Club**: The Austin Country Club has asked the RAC to integrate some of their youth swimmers in our programming while their pool is under construction. The board is evaluating this request so if the city has any feedback/input, please let us know.
- **Tennis court project**: Concrete was poured for the two lower courts on June 11. It takes 30 days to cure and then can be painted. In order to be used, ADA access must be built. We expect the lower courts to be ready for play in late July, barring any unforeseen delays. The same thing will happen with the two upper courts. Court 3 is expected to be ready in early August, and court 4 in late August. We anticipate substantial completion of the project by late August, with punch list completion shortly after that.
- **Parking**: Members are frustrated about parking at the club while construction is happening. The construction company's team members and subcontractors are being asked to park on the street and ensure that heavy equipment and trucks do not stage in the parking lot. Three or four spaces in the parking lot will be used to stage materials that cannot be put elsewhere.

- **4th of July**: The Rollingwood Women's Club will host part of its annual Independence Day celebration at the club following the Rollingwood Parade, July 4 from 10:30 a.m. - noon. The whole community is invited to attend the Women's Club event. We will revert to members-only at noon.
