11	WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Travis Central Appraisal District has prepared
12	certified, and submitted to the tax assessor/collector the appraisal roll of the City of Rollingwood
13	Texas (the "City") for 2024; and
14 15	WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the 2024 certified appraisal roll represents the
15 16	total appraised, assessed and taxable value of all property and the total taxable value of new
17	property within the City as \$70,218,461; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, the City Council finds the tax rate to be levied for 2024 (fiscal year 2024
20	2025) set by this ordinance is based on the appraisal roll and is sufficient to provide the tax
21	revenues required by the City; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, the City Council finds all requirements contained in the Texas Tax Code
24	have been met and all required notices have been issued in accordance with Texas law permitting
25 26	this tax levy; and
26 27	WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this Ordinance is in compliance with Texas Tax
28	Code §26.05(b)(1)(A) and 26.05(b)(1)(B) by including the following statement in type larger than
29	the type used in any other portion of this Ordinance:

31	THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE
32	AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

34	THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3 PERCENT
